## Pastoral Supervision & Reflective Practice

This course aims to provide trainees with a creative and professional learning experience. It will blend both theoretical and practical aspects of supervision while developing the confidence and competence to offer pastoral supervision in a wide range of contexts. The course aims to support trainees:

- Become grounded in current supervisory theories and frameworks and attend to the hidden dynamics within the supervisory relationship.
- Work ethically, recognising the interpersonal, organisational, and professional challenges posed by supervision and reflective practice.
- Attend to the hidden dynamics within the supervisory relationship.
- Attain the necessary skill and confidence to supervise in a wide range of contexts.
- Progress (if desirable) toward accreditation as a supervisor with the Association for Pastoral Supervision and Education (APSE) [www.pastoralsupervision.org.uk](http://www.pastoralsupervision.org.uk).

**Trainers: Susan Woodhead and Tony Nolan**

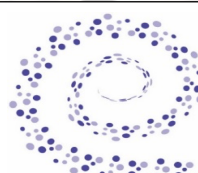
